Nearby the venue hotel but away from the competition terrains.


#### Clothing

#### 8. Transportation / Airport Pick-up

Participants arriving thru Seoul/Inchon Airport will be guided by KARL members and will move to Hwaseong city by bus. Those who arrive thru Gimpo Airport as

same. However, those who arrive thru Busan/Kimhae Airport will be guided by KARL members as well but their transportation fee/fare to Hwaseong City shall be borne at their own cost. Those who arrive to any of seaport(s) in Korea, they will be met by a KARL member at the arriving port but their transportation cost to Hwaseong city shall be paid by themselves.
