## VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Competition areas are at height 600 to 1000 meters ASL, there is a big possibility of lower temperatures in the competition area or rain so warmer clothes are preferred.

On the day of the competition, the use of any telecommunication device by competitors or team officials is prohibited until permitted by the organizers. The penalty for this shall be disqualification. If the team official breaks this rule, the whole team shall be disqualified.

We recommend using direct emergency numbers in the case of danger (997, 999, 998) because in some areas the general emergency number (112) still does not work properly.

## CITY AND AROUND

**Spa Park** - In the downtown area styled on 17th century revival, with exotic plants and a mineral water pump room. It is a perfect place for an afternoon walk. In the Park there is a building built in 1772 called Small Castle, now it is a sanatorium.

**The pump-room** of mineral water with Concert Hall (st. Zdrojowa). You can taste here good water and admire frescoes of A. Molnara which shows the Lower Śląsk on beginning of XX century.

**Skull Chapel in Czerwna** (st. Stanisława Moniuszki 8, 57-350 Kudowa Zdrój – Czerwna) - Skull Chapel is the only of its kind in Poland and one of three in Europe. The chapel was built in 1776 by Father Wenceslas Tomaszek. It is a great common grave of victims of the Śląsk wars and diseases of the eighteenth century. Walls and ceiling are lined with three thousand skulls and human bones, under the floor lies also human remains.

**Museum of Toys "Bajka"** (ul. Zdrojowa 46b) -Toys collected here from all over the world, some very old. You can view collections of dolls, miniature furniture, model railways and a whole lot of other interesting toys made of different materials ranging from wood, with clay, porcelain, and iron and tin.



**Stołowe Mountains**, including rocky reserves "Szczeliniec Wielki" (Great Szczeliniec - highest peak (919 meters above sea level) in Stołowe Mountains) and Mushroom Rock Trail. It is about 12 kilometers from Kudowa Zdrój.

**"Błędne Skały"** (Misleading Rocks) - They are in the Table Mountain National Park. Directions from Kudowa Zdroj to the Karłowo or red trail about 2.5 hours. There is a several hundred tourist route with a unique charm, which is exploring the often literally squeeze the narrow gaps between the rocks. Corridors height ranges from 6-8 m, the width is different - in places is only a few feet. The walk takes about 35 minutes.
